The successful applicant will fulfill the role of an academician through active contribution to teaching, research/scholarship, and service. This is a tenure track position.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Function as a member of the Leadership Team, and perform other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A post professional doctoral degree (EdD, PhD, ScD, etc.) demonstrated record of previous administrative experience as Chair, and Program Director with 6 years of higher education experience, 3 years of verifiable teaching experience in PT Education (10 years for Full Professor) are required. American board of Physical Therapy Specialties (ABPTS) certification, and a strong record of scholarship are preferred.

It is to be noted that for the purpose of continuous improvement of faculty qualifications as faculty members complete advanced degrees, certifications, licenses, etc., the faculty member will send official documentation, within 45 days of hire, to the Office of Human Resources, and the credentialing file in Academic Affairs.
